

File Hunter

Installation:

File Hunter by Plugin Everything uses the free ZXP installer you can find at aescrpts.com

- Drag the downloaded ZXP package onto the ZXP installer window
- Restart After Effects

Using File Hunter:

- File Hunter is designed to be intuitive and easy to use
- Navigate to Window > Extensions > File Hunter
- Set your depth option (defaults to 5)
Depth controls how many subfolders File Hunter will search down before stopping. For example a depth of 5 will tell File Hunter to search 5 folders deep from the file you found, if it cannot find the file(s) it will alert you at the end of the search
- Select the file or files you wish to find
- Click "Find" File Hunter will handle the rest

Warning: If your depth setting is too high, you're potentially searching through thousands of folders or you have hundreds of files selected File Hunter will take time to find them, this is a limitation of HD read speeds.

Manual Installation:

We recommend that users use the [aescrpts manager app](https://aescrpts.com/manager-app) to automate the installation and registration process. About half the errors listed in the FAQ are avoidable by doing this. Alternatively, you can install the plugin manually in the following locations and register the plugin inside After Effects:

Windows

`C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Adobe\CEP\extensions\`

Mac

`Library/Application Support/Adobe/CEP/extensions/`

Frequently Asked Questions:


I have a problem that's not listed in the FAQ

Please include your system specs, software versions (OS, AE, plugin) and if applicable, steps to reproduce the error. Screenshots, screencaptures and example project files are invaluable for us to track down the cause of the issue. Note we are located in Australia so our timezone is generally inverted.

Where's my serial key?

If you bought the product from aescrpts, you can find the serial key in your account dashboard under My Downloads and Licenses (it's not emailed to you).




If you copied the serial key from the internet or another application, sometimes incorrect formatting can be applied. To resolve this, paste it as plain text in a web browser or note taking application, then copy that and paste it into the registration. If the issue persists, try licensing using the [aescrpts manager app](#). If the issue still persists, open a [support ticket](#).

Where is the product inside After Effects?

Extensions (.zxp) are located at Window > Extensions:

We notarized all our products with Apple to ensure they're malware-free. If you see this message, you can generally fix the issue by [allowing the permission](#) inside System Preferences. Alternatively, these permission issues can be resolved by installing using the aescrpts manager app.

After Effects crashed while using the plugin

Open a [support ticket](#) providing the steps you used to produce the crash as well as your current system specs and software versions (OS, AE, plugin version). Our first step in diagnosing and fixing these issues is to reproduce the same error on our end. Example project files, screenshots and screen recordings are very helpful.
